- 5. Complete the FAFSA application and submit SAR (Student Aid Report).

Have a minimum **3.0** Grade Point Average (GPA), have all required college prerequisites and have been accepted into program of choice.

Requirements

Students awarded this scholarship MUST:

- 7. Be TSI ready and have Meningitis vaccine.
- 8. Enroll in an approved two-year program at either Houston Community College or San Jacinto College.
- 9. Submit a copy of your student account summary upon registration each semester.
- 10. Submit a copy of your unofficial transcript at the end of each semester.
- 11. Complete the approved program within two years of your Scholarship award.
- 12. Return all items purchased back to the Foundation **if** student does **not** complete the program within the two-year period.
- 13. Comply with all terms on Student Agreement, Page 6 of the Scholarship Application.
